2ND MILE MISSION

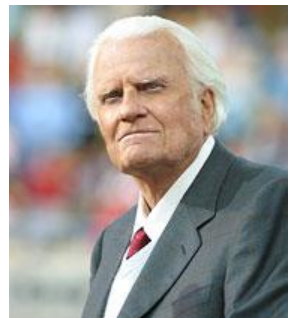

"ABANDONED" by Stan Telchin

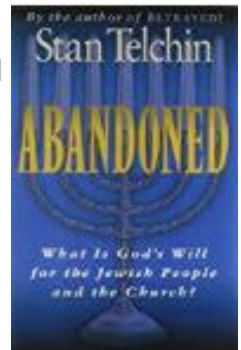
Does God still love the Jews? Why are they to oppressed and disliked? Is it a punishment? Do many become Christians? Are Jews Jewish in culture or religion?

Do you have one? Food for thought!

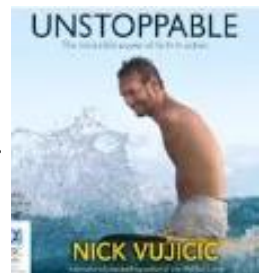


NEW IN THE LIBRARY
